## BOARDING HOUSE RULES

(i) Use of mobile phones in Boarding House is strictly prohibited. If any child is found using a mobile phone, it will be ceased immediately.
(ii) Parents are allowed to speak to their wards only on the designated days and timings. All calls will be restricted to three minutes only as telephone calls cause hindrances in the routine of school including studies of the students.
(iii) Parents are allowed to communicate with their wards on the school telephone lines on particular days and timings which can be ascertained from the House Master. No calls for speaking to wards will be entertained at any personal numbers of staff of school. However, urgent messages from parents will be passed on to their wards as and when received on school telephone numbers. While speaking to their wards, parents are to exercise restraint as far as call timings are concerned. Stipulated time is three minutes only.
(iv) The presence on the re-opening day after Summer Vacation/Diwali/ Winter Break is mandatory, failing which the student will not be accepted back in school. Such indiscipline will also lead to penalty in the forthcoming examinations (FAs/SAs).
(v) In addition to that a fine of Rs 300/- per day is imposed for joining late, unless the Principal is informed before the beginning of the term and the Principal is satisfied with the reason for late coming. Apart from this, if a child absents himself/herself for five days consecutively, his/her name will be struck off from the School. Re-admission will be the sole discretion of the Principal in this case.
(vi) Every student is expected to take care of their belongings.
(vii) The parents are not allowed to provide tuck, money, etc to their wards.
(viii) It will be the responsibility of parents to inform the school at least one day in advance regarding their arrival for celebration of birthday of their ward. Birthday celebrations are permitted in the presence of parents only during evening snacks time for which parents are to inform the House Master atleast one day in advance. No impromptu celebrations will be permitted.
(ix) Dormitories are strictly 'Out of Bounds' parents or visitors at all times except the beginning of session/ new admission.
(x) Parents are allowed to meet their wards at the reception only.
(xi) Visiting Days \& Hours: Parents are allowed to meet their wards on every second and last Sunday of a month as per the following schedule:

- Between 1000 to 1300 hrs from 01 March to 31 October.
- Between 1100 to 1400 hrs from 01 Novemberto 28 / 29 February
(xii) List of Contrabands
- Electric/Electronic Gadgets including FM Radio, Cellular Phones, Video Games, MP 3 Players, etc
- Cash \& tuck
- Hair colours, Dyes, Hair Styling Gel \& Fashion Accessories such as Bracelets, Chains, Rings, etc
- Gold/Silver Jewellery of any kind

## INVESTITURE CEREMONY

The prefects of our school are selected by faculty and the house staff. The student council is selected in investiture ceremony. The prefectural system is made up of head girl and head boy of school. House captain \& vice captain of each house and sports captains for boys \& girls respectively. While serving as prefects, they learn, that with authority comes responsibility and all its associated challenges in a hope of creating conscience and responsible citizen. The prefects are regularly advised and guided by school advisors.


## FEE

The fee structure of the Vinayak International School is directly proportionate to the facilities provided by the school and is subject to review at beginning of every academic session. The admission fee is non refundable. The security deposit is refundable after making necessary adjustment as applicable. The fees are changed on yearly basis and fee payments are made online through RTGS/NEFT or through DD/Cheques by School App. No Cash payments are entertained by school

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The Academic Session of the school starts from 1st April and ends on 31st March. The admission process is designed to enrol students demonstrating promise. A registration from is included with the prospectus or it can be done online. Registration does not imply admission, but it is subject to the clearing of the admission test conducted by school and availability of the seats and fulfilling admission criteria as laid by school. The registration fee is non refundable

## WITHDRAWAL/ REMOVAL

Once calendar month's notice in written must be given to the appropriate school authority for withdrawal the child from the school. In the absence of this the entire school fee for the session becomes payable. Those, who leave the school in the month of May, must pay all the fees and dues till September, T.C. for withdrawal is not issued until all the dues of the school are settled and paid.

## TRANSPORT

The need for safe passage of each child to school and back home is of paramount importance to us. To ensure safe travel the school has its own fleet of school buses designed as per standards and manned by trained drivers and personnel sensitized to the needs of small children. For supervision and monitoring a transport attendant is on board throughout the journey. Mobile phones have been provided in each bus that ensures efficiency in terms of service and better communication in case of emergencies. Besides ensuring the implementation of the safety norms, all staff on the bus is well trained in first aid and emergency management


## ABSENCE - LEAVE - LATE ARRIVAL IN SCHOOL

1. Parents and guardians will appreciate that absence during the term is not in the best interest of the student. They are asked not to apply for leave if avoidable, but a proper leave application has to be submitted under any circumstances. Leave can be granted to the student only on the following grounds:

- In case of serious illness or demise of a very near relative.
- To attend the marriage of his / her sibling, uncle or aunt.
- Any other occasion deemed fit by the school authorities
- Leave will not be granted for more than four days.

2. No student who has been absent on the previous day will be allowed to attend class until the parent fills up the "Record for Non-Attendance" for each day the student has been absent from school, stating the reasons for absence.
3. A student, returning to school after recovering from an infectious or contagious disease, should produce a doctor's fitness certificate permitting him / her to do so. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to school:

| Chicken Pox | Till the scabs fall off completely. |
| :--- | :--- |
| Cholera | Till the child has completely recovered. |
| Measles | Two weeks after the rash disappears. |
| Mumps | Until the swelling has gone; about one month. |
| Whooping Cough | Six weeks. |
| Jaundice | Six weeks. |

1. Students who require medical attention during school hours, will be sent to the school infirmary with the concerned teacher's signature on the "School Infirmary Record".
2. Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than six consecutive days renders the student liable to have his / her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted solely at the discretion of the Principal and only after payment of a fresh admission fee.
3. The students are required to seek written permission for leave prior to the commencement of the leave. In case the leave is taken on medical grounds, an authentic medical certificate has to be produced.
4. Leave for half day is not allowed at all, for security reasons. In emergency however, written permission for leave must be taken from the Principal /

Vice Principal / Co-ordinator / Headmistress / Headmaster and the Class Teacher and the Bus In-charge should be informed, in case the student is availing the School transport facility.
5. It is compulsory for the students to maintain at least $75 \%$ attendance in each semester. The percentage can be relaxed only on genuine medical grounds.
6. If a child is absent continuously for more than three days due to medical reasons, then a letter from parents must be accompanied by a medical certificate.
A letter has to be submitted positively to the class teacher in case of any absence.
The management of the school reserves the right to alter/change the school timings as and when the circumstance warrants

## LATE ARRIVAL IN SCHOOL

1. The school gate will close at $7.30 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. in the morning every day.
2. Students arriving late will not be allowed to enter the school. Necessary disciplinary action will be taken if they continue to loiter around the school premises.

## WITHDRAWALS

1. One clear calendar month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of notice must be given before the pupil is withdrawn.
2. Those who leave school in between sessions must in all cases pay the fees for the month last attended. Transfer Certificate will not be issued until all the dues of the school are settled.
3. The Caution Money not claimed up to three (3) years from the date of notice of withdrawal, will be forfeited.

Vinayak International School has a crystal-clear concept for MOTHER TEACHER who helps students to acquire knowledge, competence or virtue Understanding the child and developing a support between the learner and the teacher. Helps in better understanding of various development stages of the child especially cognitive and emotional. An insight into child's behavioral problems observed by the teacher. Therefore, VIS has Mother Teachers Concept in all the classes of Pre-Primary wing from PreNursery to Class II supported by an assistant teacher and a governess. VIS pre primary aims at the total development of the child's- physical, motor, emotional, social, cognitive language and moral skills. It is important to note that attendance in preschools ensures better foundation for academic achievements. The learning pedagogy at VIS focus includes physical, cognitive, social and emotional development of the child. Designing of the classrooms is done in a way that reflects on the child centred pedagogy and reflects how the ideal classroom should be. Importance of play-based learning, social and emotional dealing with children, story enactment and role play, joy of teaching and learning through art and music, STEAM (Science Technology Engineering Art and Mathematics) based activities, pottery, learning about textiles and differentiate between various yarns, learning how to type at a young age and instill cognition in children is given special importance in the curriculum.
